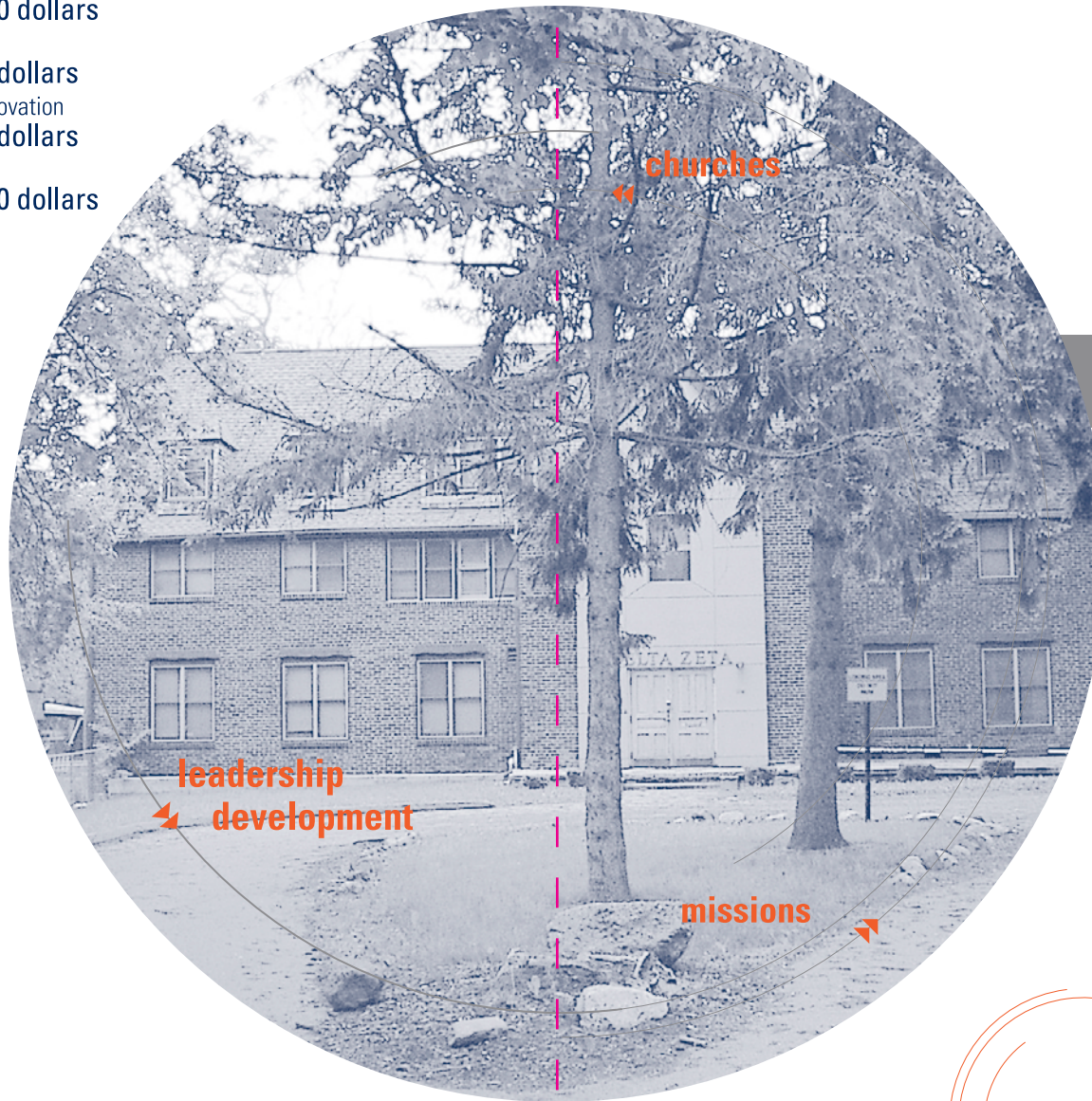

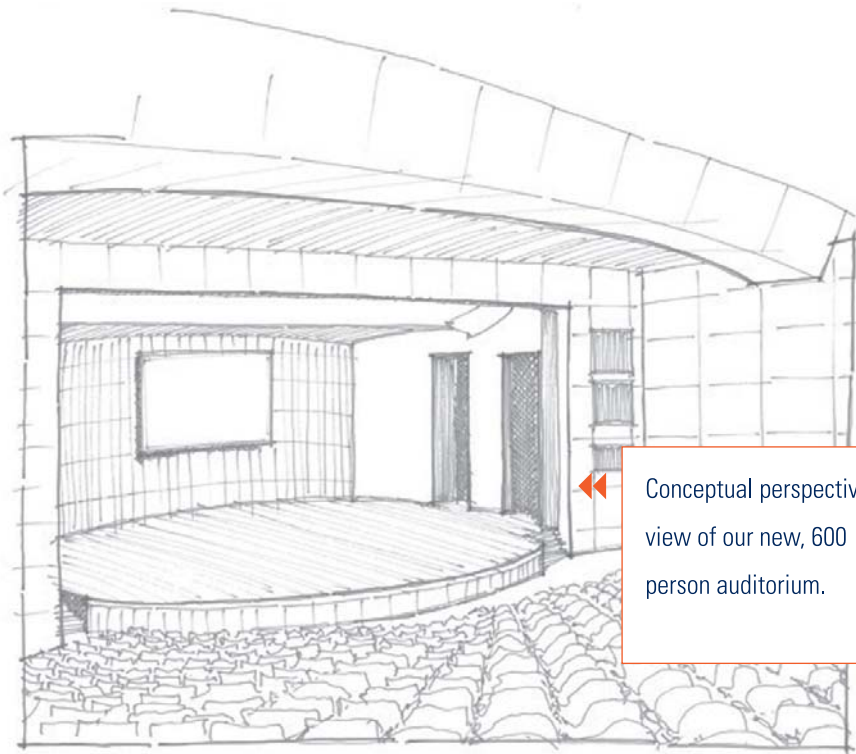

5 REASONS WHY IT'S TIME TO BUILD NOW:

▶▶ 1 **We are running out of room!**

In less than 5 years, we have grown from a church of 20 students and a handful of families to a church serving an average of around 500 people on a typical Sunday morning. At the present, we are renting the largest auditorium space the University of Michigan will allow us, while running as many services as possible. Even so, we are on track to run out of space as early as the fall of 2003!

After the new auditorium is completed, however, we'll have over 600 seats available without a limitation on the number of services we can run, which could extend our capacity from the 600 – 700 range we currently have to nearly 2400 on a Sunday morning (roughly 10% of the entire undergraduate student body).

2 **We need a quality ministry environment!**

At New Life Church, we want everyone who steps through our doors to feel welcome. Right now, our present facilities serve more as a challenge than a support to us in this regard.

With an auditorium designed specifically for our ministry style, we can make the move from make-shift to exceptional. Imagine an entire auditorium designed specifically to enhance our ability to impact college students and raise up the next generation of workers to build God's Kingdom.

3 **We are facing a constant threat of extinction!**

In recent years, we have used over 7 different auditoriums. On 2 separate occasions we were actually "kicked out" with a week's notice on the disapproval of a single individual from the university. Though our relationship with them has improved slightly, we face a constant threat of homelessness. *Building our own auditorium on campus will change all that!*

4 **We're losing time!**

It takes a great deal of sacrifice to be a literally portable church. Every single Sunday we set up our entire service from boxes and boxes of equipment in a storage unit. After the service we do it all over again in reverse. With an auditorium of our own, we could spend much less time carrying equipment and much more time building God's Kingdom.

5 **We could become a permanent evangelical presence on campus!**

Each year, thousands of tomorrow's leaders pack up all their worldly possessions and become our new neighbors. We are uniquely positioned and fully focused on making disciples and workers for Christ with this population.
